Dear God,

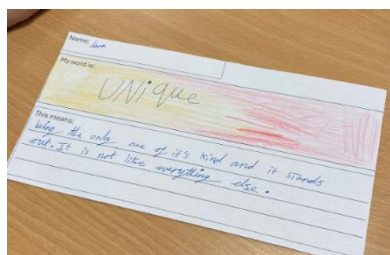


Book Week 2025
