We are very proud of distinct, smart uniform and we believe that high standards of uniform should be maintained in school. We feel that wearing the school uniform gives the children a sense of belonging to our school.

Parents are asked to comply with the following guidelines.

Winter Uniform - (May be worn from September but must be worn from October half term until Easter)

Grey skirt / pinafore dress / grey tailored trousers

White shirt or blouse with a collar and school tie (with exception of reception children who wear a white polo t-shirt, no tie)

Grey/black tights Grey/black / white socks School jumper or cardigan with school logo

Summer Uniform – May Half Term Onwards (but may be worn from Easter to October half term)

Blue and white gingham dress **or** White polo neck shirt and grey shorts

School jumper or cardigan with school logo

Grey/white socks or tights

PE and Games

School PE t-shirt (Blue with Logo)

*School Blue PE shorts

*School Hoodie and tracksuit bottoms

Plain (no visible sports logo's) blue or black base layer (November to March) -

Trainers and Plimsolls

***Having the school logo is optional, plain blue (not navy) PE shorts, hoodie and tracksuit bottoms are permitted (with no sports logo's)**

Shoes

Children must wear black, closed shoes (either laced or straps) - boots are not permitted.

For Swimming

Children are required to wear all in one swimming costume or swim shorts (not board shorts).

Swim hat

Towel

Flip flops

Goggles (optional)

All PE kit should be stored in a named drawstring bag (available from school office), this must be brought in on Monday morning and taken home on Friday afternoon.

All items of school uniform, shoes and equipment must be clearly labelled.

Where required, school will consider making any reasonable adjustments to the uniform for any of our SEND children.

Jumpers/Cardigans/School ties are available to buy from the school office along with book bags, ruck sacks, PE bags and swimming hats. The remaining items of school uniform are available from School Days Direct in Slough and Goyal's in Maidenhead.

Jewellery

One pair of plain studs (one per ear) Metal/Gold/Silver/White or Navy may be worn A simple, plain watch with a dark coloured strap may be worn (smart watches are not permitted) All earrings must be removed for

games / PE (not taped over). If a child chooses to remove their earrings at school for their PE lesson, they must do so independently and provide their own storage container. School will not accept any responsibility for jewellery that is removed for a PE lesson. We advise parents to arrange to 3 of 4 have their children's ears pierced at the beginning of the summer holidays to allow time for them to heal before returning to school.

Hair

Shoulder length hair should be tied back with a **plain** navy, yellow or black hair tie. **Plain** headbands or hair clips in navy or black are acceptable. Blue and white gingham hair accessories are only to be worn with summer dresses (Colour and beads are not appropriate). Hair should not be shaved or dyed. No hair gel is permitted. Hair Styles Long hair needs to be tied back for school. Fashions in hair styles come and go; extreme or out of the ordinary hair styles draw attention to the child and often cause problems. Please do not have the child's hair cut too short (grade 1) or with logos cut into the hair. If it is felt the haircut is inappropriate for school, you will be contacted and asked to address the issue.

The Headteacher reserves the right to say when clothing, hairstyle, jewellery or make-up is not suitable.
