What to do if...	Action Needed	Return to school when...
<p>...my child has COVID-19 symptoms. For symptoms please see the NHS website: https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not send your child to school. - Contact school to inform us. - Any household members over 18 and 6 months and not fully vaccinated should self-isolate for 10 days - Your child and all family members should get a PCR test. - Inform the school immediately about the test result. 	<p>...the test comes back negative or a period of 10 days has passed since the symptoms started, and the child feels well.</p>
<p>...my child tests positive for COVID-19.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not send your child to school. - Contact school to inform us. - Agree an earliest date for possible return (minimum of 10 days). - Any household members over 18 and 6 months and not fully vaccinated should self-isolate for 10 days - Other household members should get a PCR test if they have not already done so. 	<p>...10 days have passed since symptoms began, even if they still have a cough or loss of taste/smell. <i>(These symptoms can last for several weeks.)</i> AND the child feels well.</p>
<p>...my child tests negative.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Contact school to inform us. - Discuss when your child can come back (same day/next day). 	<p>...the test comes back negative.</p>
<p>...my child is ill with symptoms not linked to COVID-19.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Send your child to school if they are well enough. - Contact school to inform us if your child is not well enough. - Ring on each day of illness. 	<p>...after 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea.</p>
<p>...someone in my household has COVID-19 symptoms.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Send your child to school provided they have no symptoms - Contact school to inform us. - The household member with symptoms should self-isolate and get a PCR test. They should NOT leave the house until they receive the result. This includes doing pick-ups and drop offs <i>(please contact school if you need support getting your child to school)</i>. If the test result is positive, they should self-isolate from the day the symptoms started and the next 10 full days 	<p>...your child can continue to attend school.</p>

	<p>- Inform school immediately about test result.</p>	
<p>...someone in my household tests positive for COVID-19.</p>	<p>- Send your child to school provided they have no symptoms</p> <p>- Contact school to inform us.</p> <p>- The household member who has tested positive should NOT leave the house, including to do pick-ups and drop offs (<i>please contact school if you need support getting your child to school</i>).</p> <p>- Any household members over 18 and 6 months and not fully vaccinated should self-isolate for 10 days</p>	<p>...your child can continue to attend school.</p>
<p>...NHS test and trace has identified my child as a contact of someone with COVID-19.</p>	<p>- send your child to school provided they have no symptoms.</p> <p>- Contact school to inform us.</p>	<p>...your child can continue to attend school.</p>
<p>...NHS test and trace has identified a household member (other than my child) as a close contact of somebody with symptoms or confirmed COVID-19.</p>	<p>- The household member must self-isolate for 10 days.</p> <p>- Your child can continue to attend school.</p>	<p>...your child can continue to attend school.</p>
<p>...my child's bubble is closed due to a COVID-19 outbreak in school.</p>	<p>- Child must not come to school.</p> <p>- Support your child at home with remote education on Teams.</p> <p>- Other siblings may continue to attend school.</p>	<p>...school informs you that the bubble will be reopened.</p>
