P.E. and GAMES

Towel, swim hat, flip flops and goggles if preferred.</p>	
<p>All items of school uniform, shoes and equipment must be clearly labelled. Jumpers, cardigans and school ties are available to buy from the school office along with book bags, ruck sacks, P.E. bags, water bottles, berol pens and swimming hats. Remaining items of school uniform are available from Goyals, Bridge Street, Maidenhead and School Days along the A4</p>	

Summer or winter uniform may be worn until May half term, after this date all children should wear summer uniform.

All P.E. kit should be stored in a named drawstring bag (available from school office), this must be stored in school except during holiday periods.

A pair of simple stud earrings, small religious jewellery items and a watch may be worn for school but these must be removed for all P.E. and games lessons.
